### **Introduction & Purpose of the Meeting**

### **What's Happened in Surrey in during 2009/2010**

Club sweatshirts were printed and were sold to staff and players at cost.

### **What's is Planned for Next Year**

Moving back to Farnham Sports Centre after it's £5m refit on 9<sup>th</sup> October.

FSC sports hall will include floorball floor and wall markings

Hopefully a Farnham schools tournament will take place on the afternoon of 20<sup>th</sup> November. If not, there will be a Shooting Stars friendly match against Hale School on that date.

Active Surrey accreditation was achieved although there have not been any tangible benefits of this yet.

## **Accounts**

Tom's Dad, Chris Wilde (ACA) has very kindly certified our accounts free of charge and these were approved by the meeting.

- Subs collected were up from £2475 to £3737 due to SS sessions starting 28<sup>th</sup> March 2009.
- Net loss up from £159 to £675, net balance -£647
- Equipment purchases £706 during 2009/2010.

Recovery plan: no more equipment needed, increase player attendance, no increase in club prices to players is planned (due to recession).
